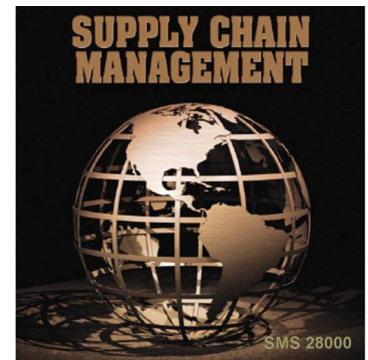

SMS 28000, Security in the Supply Chain

BRS in the Supply Chain, a legally binding Charter



SMS 28000 based on published ISO 28000

Organizations establish, implement and update security controls within the scope of their supply chain as to ensure business continuity. These address vulnerabilities to seek that the supply—chain flow uninterrupted. To pursue assurance based BRS P|E|R|M principles (prevent—eliminate—reduce—mitigate) to manage security is essential. To this effect the International Organization for Standardization (ISO, Europe) has published ISO 28000. BRS drives from C-TPAT in the USA, a valuable arrangement driving SMS (ISO) 28000.

Initially published in 2007, ISO 28000 derives from C-TPAT and represents a set of industry specification providing management principles to industry; sets forth guiding requirements for a management system to ensure security of a supply chain.

Benefits of SMS 28000:

- Provides for confidence within the interested parties, that the organization addresses critical vulnerabilities in the pursuit to assure continuous flow.
- Provides a management tool to help in identification of threats and control.

- Demonstrate competence in managing security.
- Provides for the appropriate and adequate establishment, implementation and update based contemporary security management.
- Consumer-Centric Customer satisfaction.

Certification—BRS is a consumer-centric certification body with accreditation sustained by an Attorney General | Department of Justice and the Federal Department of the Treasury.

C-TPAT

The **Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (C-TPAT)** is a voluntary supply chain security program led by the U.S. Custom Border Protection (CBP). C-TPAT focus sustaining and on improving the security of private companies' supply chains with respect to sabotage, in-

tended harm and terrorism. Other countries have copied the C-TPAT program.

SMS 28000 provides a threshold to programs such as C-TPAT.

As a Certification Body, BRS cannot implement or address as “how” to implement SMS 28000, BRS however address



any question to answer “what”.
